The Revision impugns the Order dated 18.10.2023 made by the Additional District Judge-II, Kotri, dismissing Civil Appeal No.53 of 2023 preferred by the Applicant as being time barred upon dismissal of the Application moved by him under Section 5 of the Limitation Act seeking condonation of the delay. A perusal of the Order Sheet reflects that time had been sought by Counsel for the Applicant on the previous date to address the question of limitation, however no one is in attendance behalf of the Applicant today and no intimation has been received. The record reflects that date of the underlying Judgment and Decree to be 24.12.2022, whereas the Appeal was filed on 06.09.2023, after around seven months, with no cogent ground having been raised for condonation in terms of the Application presented under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, in as much as it merely raises a vague ground as to the Applicant's professed unawareness that the Judgment and Decree had been passed. Needless to say, it was the duty of the Applicant to have remained vigilant and such a ground scarcely suffices as a valid ground for condonation in the matter. Under the given circumstances, no illegality or material irregularity is found to afflict the Order of the appellate forum. The Revision Application thus stands dismissed accordingly.
