A suit without a contest was decreed exparte. Aggrieved of it an application under section 12(2) CPC was preferred, which was dismissed. The order of the trial Court passed on the said application under section 12(2) CPC dated 02.09.2022 disclosed that perhaps evidence was recorded in pursuance thereof and eventually the same was dismissed. Civil Revision Application was then preferred wherein the matter was remanded to the trial Court setting aside the order of the trial Court passed on the application under section 12(2) CPC.

We have heard learned counsel for petitioner and perused material available on record.

No doubt the application under section 12(2) CPC was disposed of by the trial Court after recording evidence but we are exercising jurisdiction under Article 199 of Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 and cannot be an appellate Court of the two forums below; only jurisdictional error floating on the face of it or any order which transgressed constitutional safeguards could be taken into account while exercising such jurisdiction. No such point has either been raised or could at least be discovered after perusal of the impugned order. It is only a remand to the trial Court for a decision afresh in accordance with law.

In view of above no interference is required. The petition being misconceived is dismissed along with listed applications.
