It appears that this aspect of the matter cannot be examined by this Court under Constitutional jurisdiction under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, however, the petitioner will be at liberty to approach the relevant authority by lodging complaint, who shall entertain the same and decide his grievance, if any, after hearing the parties, in accordance with law.

In view of hereinabove position, instant Constitution Petition merits no consideration and is accordingly dismissed in limine alongwith listed application.
