Mr. Mir Muhammad Nohri advocate for the petitioners. Mr. Allah Bachayo Soomro, Addl. A.G Sindh with Mr. Muhammad Ismail Bhutto, Addl: A.G along with PI Muhammad Changal on behalf of SSP, Hyderabad.

Office objection raises the issue of *locus standi*. On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:

"Learned A.A.G files progress report / comments on behalf of the official respondents, copy whereof is provided to learned counsel for petitioners who seeks time to go through the same. However, learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to satisfy this Court as to locus standi of members of Civil Society / Petitioner to maintain this petition."

Today counsel for the petitioners has admitted that the petitioners have no *locus standi* per se in the present matter. Article 199 of the Constitution is available for aggrieved persons and the petitioners' counsel has remained unable to befall the petitioners in the said category.
