ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. The petitioner Mst. Marvi has filed this petition under Article 199 of The Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, seeking protection against the highhandedness of private respondents, who in connivance with the official respondents are causing harassment and have made her life miserable due to free will marriage of Mst. Hira with the son of petitioner Raheel Ali.

2. The learned A.A.G has submitted that son of the petitioner had filed Criminal Miscellaneous Application No.458 of 2024 before this Court which was disposed of vide order dated 13-08-2024 upon the statement of Inspector Junaid Qamar, SHO P.S Mirwah Gorchani. Learned A.A.G submitted that now the mother of applicant Raheel Ali has filed this Constitutional Petition on the same cause of action which is not entertainable by this Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that son of the petitioner entered into marriage with Mst. Hira on 04-07-2024 and this is a reason the police officials are causing harassment to the petitioner and this is her fundamental right to seek protection of law. The police official present in Court has submitted that no harassment shall be caused to either party and they will act strictly in accordance with law. The learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied with such statement of the police official and seeks disposal of this petition in terms of the statement.

4. In view of the above, the purpose of filing this petition has been served and is disposed of in terms of orders passed by this court in earlier litigation as well as the statement made by the police official present in Court.
