<u>ORDER</u>

Zulfigar Ahmad Khan J.- Counsel for the applicant has placed on record certain documents through statement to show that in fact the applicant's date of birth is 23.09.1962 instead of 23.09.1960. NADRA record has also been produced. Counsel for respondent No.6 states that they have no objection to correct the record with regard to date of birth of applicant in school certificates including matriculation certificate. Learned AAG states that they have also no objection provided that however no pecuniary benefits be allowed to the applicant on the basis of change in date of birth.

2. Counsel for applicant states that applicant's date of birth in service record is already 23.09.1962, therefore, no pecuniary benefits with regard to change of birth would be availed by the applicant; however, states that mere on account of pendency of litigation, applicant's pensionary benefits arising out of date of birth of 23.09.1962, which is already as per service record, has been withheld without any cogent reason.

In the circumstances, instant Civil Revision is allowed and the judgments of the two Courts below are set aside. Let date of birth of applicant be corrected from 23.09.1960 to 23.09.1962 in the record of

schools. With regard to service benefits, applicant's date of birth is already recorded as 23.09.1962 as per service record, therefore, no prejudice be caused on account of any discrepancy in the date of birth.
