None present for the petitioner / applicant. On the last date of hearing, a brief was held for Mr. Shafqat Rahim Rajput, Counsel for the petitioner / applicant and even on prior date a brief was held for him. Learned AAG Sindh states that this petition was disposed of vide order dated 07.12.2020 with the following operating part:

“Having heard the learned Counsels and gone through the record. In order to acquire legal status for any specific amount, this matter stands disposed of with the direction that the applicant may approach the Land Acquisition Officer within a period of one month whereafter it is reasonably expected that the learned Land Acquisition Officer will make a sincere attempt to conclude the entitlement if any of the applicant alongwith quantum of the same in accordance with law and that such exercise be completed within a period of six months. Amount deposited with the learned Additional Registrar in the said circumstances shall be accordingly dealt by the finality of the order of Land Acquisition Officer.”

Thereafter, the petitioner approached to concerned authority, which after hearing him passed an order dated 19.05.2022, and a compliance report was furnished to this Court on 20.05.2022 also. It appears that the contempt application was moved for the period when such representation was still pending and the petitioner sought this Court’s indulgence to have the matter decided. Once the matter has been decided on the given date,

no effective appearance has been made to this Court, and it is the reason to believe that the petitioner might have resorted to all his applicable remedies or the purpose of filing this petition was served.

In the circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that the compliance of this Court's order has been made. Accordingly, contempt application is **dismissed**, however, the petitioner would be at liberty to pursue his legal remedies in accordance with law.
