ORDER

MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO, J:- These petitions seeking directions to respondents/relevant Sukkur Municipal Corporation authorities to pay outstanding amount of overtime, part of salaries of the petitioners, were disposed of by a common order dated 22.09.2022, when learned counsel for respondents filed a breakup regarding outstanding amount of overtime, being part of petitioners' salaries in view of Sindh People's Municipality Sukkur Fire Brigade Staff (Overtime) Rules, 1976, and learned counsel for petitioners accepted calculation endorsed in the break up. And hence respondents were directed to pay the said amount to the petitioners. Thereafter, listed applications under Article 204 of the Constitution have been filed for taking action against the alleged contemnors for not complying with the Court's orders.

2. Learned counsel for respondents has filed a computer generated table duly attested by Accounts Officer, SMC datelining in different columns, headed as paid month, year, cheque number, amount deposited in the bank along with details of bank accounts of employees, in which relevant amount was deposited. Learned counsel for petitioners and the petitioner present in person have, however, disputed

even the figures in the table and amount deposited in their bank accounts. Since now the dispute between the parties appears to be on factual aspects of the matter, listed applications are **disposed of** and the petitioners are directed to approach the Appellate Tribunal Local Councils Sindh at Sukkur, notified on 10.11.2023 for redressal of their grievances.
