Mr. Abdul Baqi Jan Kakar has filed power on behalf of petitioner No.1, which is taken on record.

We have heard the parties to some extent and have come to know that a Special Court for deciding disputes of Cooperative Societies in pursuance of Section 73 of the Sindh Cooperative Societies Act, 2020, has been established and functioning. The Honourable Chief Justice of this Court has been pleased to designate learned 2nd Senior Civil Judge/Assistant Sessions Judge, Sukkur to act as a Special Court for Cooperative Societies of Sukkur Division. Section 117(2) of the Sindh Cooperative Societies Act, 2020 provides that on establishment of Special Courts under subsection (1), the cases falling within the purview of this Act pending in any Court shall be transferred to the Special Court for trial.

We, therefore, in the light of above provisions, with consent, transmit this petition to the Special Court for Cooperative Societies, Sukkur Division, and direct the said Court to decide the case strictly in terms of sub-section (3) of section 117 of the ibid Act.

The petition in the above terms stands **transmitted** to the Court of learned 2nd Senior Civil Judge / Assistant Sessions Judge, Sukkur / Special Court for Cooperative Societies, Sukkur Division along with listed applications.
