<u>O R D E R</u>

Petitioner, an electricity consumer under Meter No.SP-12756, is aggrieved by alleged incorrect bill issued to him by the SEPCO.

2. In response, respondent-SEPCO has filed comments. Their Advocate submits that already a summary has been moved for making correction in the electricity bills of the petitioner, on whose residence, in fact two meters have been installed and against one meter, Rs.10,15,877/- an outstanding amount, is pending. But in any case, correction in the bills and relaxation, as provided under the Rules and Policy of SEPCO, would be extended to the petitioner and he would be given relief in accordance with law. He undertakes that within two months either such exercise would be made.

3. Accordingly and in the light of above statement, petition is **disposed of.** However, after two months, compliance report be submitted for a perusal in chamber.
