Per the Report / Order dated 15.02.2024 and 29.02.2024 of the Deputy Registrar (OS) ("Report"), he has satisfied himself that all requisites to the hearing of the main petition, including its publication, have been fulfilled and no objection thereto has been received, therefore, the main petition shall be determined in terms herein.

Petitioner alongwith two witnesses and attorney of legal heirs are present. Insofar as legal heirs No.2 to 5 are concerned they have sworn their affidavits of no objection in favour of the petitioner, which are available on file.

This is a petition under Sections 278 & 372 of the Succession Act, 1925, praying for Letter of Administration and Succession Certificate in respect of the estate of late Muhammad Zafar ("Deceased"). Per the Report, the Deceased expired on 26.01.2023 at Karachi and that the petitioner and legal heirs No.2 to 5 are the legal heirs of the deceased. The death certificate and family registration certificate are stated to have been examined by the Deputy Registrar and are also available on file. The Report records the affidavits of two witnesses, which are also on file.

The estate of the deceased comprises of moveable and immovable properties mentioned in the Reports. The Reports record that the title documents in respect of the estate have been seen/verified by the Deputy Registrar. The Report also records that the publication of the main petition had been effected in the daily Jang Karachi dated 23.06.2023 but no objection has been received from any corner in such regard. The Report demonstrates that

after having satisfied himself with the completion of the requirements, the Deputy Registrar has forwarded the matter for hearing of the main petition.

In view of the foregoing, it appears that all the requisites have been completed to the satisfaction of the Deputy Registrar and there appears to be no impediment to the grant hereof, therefore, this petition is hereby allowed. The office is directed to issue letters of administration, in respect of the immovable properties recorded in the Reports, and succession certificate, in respect of the moveable properties recorded in the Reports, as per Rules.

This petition stands allowed in terms herein contained.
