- 1. Over ruled.
- 2. It is alleged that on arrest the applicant led to recovery of an unlicensed 30 bore pistol with magazine containing two live bullets of same bore, which he allegedly used while causing fire shot injuries to PW Meenhal with intention to commit his murder, for that he was booked and reported upon by the police.

On refusal of bail by the learned IIIrd Additional Sessions Judge, Khairpur, the applicant has sought for the same from this Court by way of instant application u/s 497 Cr.P.C.

Heard arguments and perused the record.

The recovery is alleged to have been foisted upon the applicant by the police at the instance of complainant party of the main case with whom he is disputed over inheritance of the property; he has already been admitted to bail in main case by this Court for causing fire shot injuries to PW Meenhal. The case has finally been challaned and there is no likelihood of absconsion or tampering with the evidence on the part of the

applicant. In these circumstances a case for release of the applicant on bail on point of further inquiry obviously is made out.

In view of above, the applicant is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing surety in sum of Rs. 30,000/- and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

Instant Bail application is disposed of accordingly.
