By this single order, we intend to dispose of the aforesaid bail applications moved on behalf of the applicants/accused Mirza Kharos, Hyder Bux Shar and Ghulam Hussain Shar separately in crime No.89/2004, registered at Police Station Dakhan, District Shikarpur, for offences under Sections 365-A, 148, 149, PPC, read with Section 7 of the Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997. Bail applications moved before the trial Court were rejected vide orders dated 14.11.2011, 8.10.2011 and 1.3.2014 respectively. Thereafter, the applicants/accused have approached this Court.

2. Learned advocates for the applicants/accused after arguing the bail applications at some length stated that they would not press the bail applications if directions are issued to the trial Court for expeditious disposal of the case as provided under the Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997.

3. Mr. Khadim Hussain Khooharo, learned D.P.G., recorded no objection if directions are issued to the trial Court for quick disposal of the case.

4. In the view of above, bail applications are dismissed as not pressed alongwith all pending applications. Trial Court is directed to proceed with the case on day to day basis and conclude the same

expeditiously as provided under the Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997. In case trial is not concluded within the period of one month, the applicants/accused would be at liberty to repeat the bail applications before the trial Court, then the same shall be decided strictly in accordance with law.

5. Before parting with this order, trial Court is directed to send the progress report weekly to this Court through the Additional Registrar for perusal.
