Today, Azizullah Odho D.E.O Jacobabad, is present in Court and states that as soon as petitioners submitted the documents, the case for their appointment shall be submitted to the competent authority. D.E.O, further submits that following formalities are to be fulfilled by the petitioners.

- (i) Copy of agreement bond signed by the applicant/plot donor and DOE concerned regarding construction of school building.
- (ii) Copy of Form VII-A/ B duly signed by the Mukhtiarkar concerned showing ownership of plot/ land of the applicant/donor.
- (iii) NOC of other shareholders of land/plot and other heirs of property.
- (iv) Present status of school.
- (v) Qualification/Domicile/PRC of the applicant.







Certificate from relevant officer that land donated for construction of (vi) school stand transferred in the name of Education & Literacy Department, Government of Sindh.

Petitioners are directed to produce aforesaid documents/certificates before D.E.O Jacobabad within seven days, thereafter case for the appointment of the petiteonrs under the policy/rules shall be forwarded to the competent authority. It is expected that entire exercise shall be completed within the period of four months by the concerned respondents.

By consent, petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
