Through the instant constitutional petition, the petitioners Qadir Bux and others have prayed for following reliefs:-

- “(a) To restrain respondents not to demolish their houses from village Qadir Bux Jat, which consist of 250-300 houses and 1000-1100 souls and other life amenities and not to make any harassment among the peasants/villages.*
- “(b) To direct respondents No.5 and 6 to provide the protection to their life and liberty as guaranteed under the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.*
- “(c) Any other relief which this Honourable Court deem fit and proper may also be awarded”.*

Notices were issued against the respondents as well as A.A.G and D.A.G.

Comments are filed by Mukhtiarkar (Land Revenue) Tando Bago, wherein it is mentioned that as per decision of the Senior Civil Judge, Badin,

08 acres right off are reserved for the village and 08 acres are reserved for the purpose of

the construction of the houses of the villagers. Learned Additional A.G Sindh refers to Para-9 of the comments that land in question is reserved for Defence Quota and as per decision of the learned Civil Court, 08 acres are reserved for the construction of the houses of the peasants. With regard to the harassment, all the allegations have been denied by the police officials.

Learned Additional A.G as well as D.A.G undertake that official respondents are bound to discharge their duties in accordance with law.

In view of the statement of the learned A.A.G and D.A.G as well as the comments filed by the official respondents, the learned Counsel for petitioners does not press the instant constitutional petition more, which is accordingly disposed of with strict directions that respondents shall act in accordance with law.
