4. Applicants/accused Noor-ud-Din, Abu-Hurrairah and Abu Turab seek protective bail in Crime No.54 of 2021, registered at Police Station Tando Ghulam Ali District Badin for offence under section 324, 114, 337-A(i), 337-F(i), 504, 427, 34 PPC.

It is *inter alia* contended that applicants/accused are prepared to surrender before the trial Court but apprehend their arrest at the hands of police for malafide reasons. It is further submitted that Court of Sessions is cordoned off by police under the influence of complainant Qadir Bux @ Sajjad Hussain. Serious malafide over cattle trespass has been alleged against the complainant and local police.

Without touching the merits of the case and in order to enable the applicants to approach the concerned Court for pre-arrest bail, protective bail is granted to the applicants/accused for a period of Seven (07) days from today subject to their furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) each and P.R Bonds in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court.

The applicants/accused are directed to surrender before the trial Court within aforesaid period. Applicants are further directed to join the investigation forthwith.

This order shall cease to have its' effect on expiry of Seven (07) days from today i.e. on 04.05.2021 or on the applicants' surrendering themselves before the concerned Court, whichever is earlier. In case applicants/accused failed to surrender before the trial Court within aforesaid period, their bail bonds shall stand automatically forfeited.

The bail application stands disposed of.
