After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel for applicant submits that that he would be satisfied and will not press instant criminal bail application if learned trial Court is directed to expedite the matter and record the evidence of complainant, his witnesses and conclude the trial within a period of 60 days. In view of the above, instant criminal bail application is **disposed of**; however, the learned trial Court is directed to record the evidence of complainant and his witnesses and conclude the trial within sixty (60) days. It is made clear that learned trial Court shall take all possible efforts to procure the attendance of witnesses and in case, the learned trial Court fails to conclude the matter within the stipulated period, the applicant would be at liberty to repeat fresh bail application on fresh ground before the learned trial Court.
