O R D E R

ZULFIQAR ALI SANGI, J:- Through these bail applications, applicants have sought for post-arrest bail in Crime No.76 of 2024 registered under sections 302, 114, 504 PPC at PS Hali Road, after dismissal of their bail plea by the learned VIIIth Additional Sessions Judge, Hyderabad vide order dated 26.07.2024, hence they approached this Court. Since both cases are inter-connected, therefore, common order is being passed.

2. As per FIR, the allegation against applicant Wali Muhammad is of instigation whereas the accusation against applicant Raashid Abbasi is of his presence at place of Vardat.

3. Complainant Mola Bux present has filed no objection affidavits in each bail application stating therein that he has no objection if bail is granted to the applicants. In view thereof, learned APG also conceded for grant of bail to applicants looking to allegations against them.

4. Heard learned counsel for respective parties and perused material available on record.

5. Perusal of record reflects that only the allegation against applicant Wali Muhammad is of instigation while applicant Raashid's presence has been shown in the FIR at place of occurrence. No direct role for causing any injury to deceased is mentioned in the FIR coupled with no objection of complainant and APG, the applicants' case require further inquiry, result thereof, these bail applications are **allowed**. The applicants are admitted to post-arrest bail subject to their furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- each and PR bonds in the like amount to the satisfaction of Trial Court.

6. The observations made hereinabove are tentative and would not influence the learned Trial Court at the time of deciding the case as the same are only for deciding these bail applications.
