Comments have been filed by respondents No.3 and 4,
taken on record.

This Court after hearing the matter of similar nature for non-technical workers in Grade 1 to 4 has passed a detailed order on 18.09.2024 and per learned counsel for the petitioners as well as accented by learned AAG Sindh, the matter at hand is identical to the subject matter of petition bearing C.P No.D-1435 of 2023, where inter alia on the basis of a decision passed in civil suit at Principal Seat more than 50,000 employments have been set aside upon the motion of learned Advocate General Sindh, against which order a number of appeals are now pending and this Court through the order dated 18.09.2024 has redressed grievance of petitioners representing lowest stratum of the society.

Learned AAG Sindh further states that in fact this Court has already passed several orders including orders passed in C.P

No.D- 868 of 2023 and 176 of 2023 as well as detailed order of C.P No. 1435 of 2023 where operation of all such orders passed in civil suit has been held to have no impediment for issuance of appointment letters to the petitioners.

In the circumstances, this petition is allowed and the respondents are directed to implement various orders passed by this Court including the order passed on 18.09.2024 in C.P No.D-1435 of 2023 and issue the present petitioners (falling in BPS-1 to BPS-4 nontechnical) appointment letters treating them as fresh appointments as the order dated 18.09.2024 passed in above Constitutional Petition is to apply *mutatis mutandis* to the present petitioners.

The petition is allowed in these terms.
