The Petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 199 of the Constitution, seeking to impugn the Order made by the Civil Judge/Family Judge No.VII Hyderabad on 11.09.2024 in Family Suit No.108 of 2021 so as to dismissan Application preferred by him for summoning certain witnesses. A perusal of that Order reflects that the Court saw fit to dismiss the Application as the evidence had already been recorded and as the Application was inherently defective as it did not even set out the addresses of the witnesses. As such, the Order appears to be correctly premised, with the challenge theretoeven otherwisebeing misconceived as a Petition does not lie in the matter, and an objection as on that score having been endorsed by the office at the time of presentation.Ergo, while sustaining the office objection the Petition stands dismissed *in limine*.
