Learned AAG Sindh, under his statement, has filed a statement of respondent No.5 in C. P. No. D-1352 of 2024, taken on record.

This Court, having considered a similar case for non-technical employees in Grades 1 to 4, has issued a comprehensive order on 18.09.2024 in C. P. No. D-1435 of 2023. According to Counsel for the petitioners and supported by the learned AAG Sindh, the current matter is comparable to petition bearing C. P. No. D-1435 of 2023. In that instance, based on a decision from a Civil Suit at the Principal Seat, over 50,000 employments were annulled upon the motion of learned Advocate General Sindh. Several appeals regarding that order are currently pending, and this Court, through its order dated 18.09.2024, addressed the concerns of the petitioners representing the lowest segments of the society.

Learned AAG Sindh further apprised that this Court has previously issued multiple orders, including C. Ps. No. D-868 of 2023 and 176 of 2023, as well as a detailed order in C. P. No. D-1435 of 2023, confirming that all orders from the Civil Suit do not obstruct the issuance of appointment letters to the petitioners. In these circumstances, all these petitions are **allowed**, and the respondents are directed to enforce the various orders issued by this Court, including the order dated 18.09.2024 passed in C. P. No. D-1435 of 2023, and issue the present petitioners (falling in BPS-1 to BPS-4 – nontechnical) appointment letters treating the same as fresh appointments in accordance with the order dated 18.09.2024 passed in above Constitutional Petition, which is to be applied *mutatis mutandis* to them.

The petitions are **disposed of** in these terms, along with any pending applications. Office to place a signed copy of this order in the captioned connected matters.
