Learned Counsel for the petitioner through a statement has filed several documents, taken on record. Petitioner has filed this petition seeking directions to respondents to appoint him on the basis of deceased quota as per scheme of Rule 11-A of the Sindh Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1974, in accordance with law. However, as stated by learned AAG Sindh, this very rule is not applicable in the case of petitioner as his father was a public servant employed in Municipal Corporation, Sukkur.

Faced with this situation, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the case of petitioner on humanitarian basis. This request appears to be reasonable, and the petition is **disposed of**. Respondents may consider the request of the petitioner for appointment on humanitarian ground.
