Mr. Asif Ali Bhutto, advocate for the applicants along with applicants, namely, Saif Ali and Aleem.

1. Urgency granted.
2. Overruled.
3. Exemption application disposed of.
4. Through this Crl. Bail Application, applicants, namely, Saif Ali and Aleem both sons of Aftab Ali Bhutto, seek protective bail in Crime No.18 of 2020 registered at Police Station Garhi Khuda Bux Bhutto, under sections 3337-A(i), F-(i), 504, 147, 148, 149, 114, PPC.

Learned counsel for the applicants, *inter alia*, contended that the applicants had no knowledge regarding registration of the case against them so also submission of the challan. Serious malafide on the part of the complainant Allah Warayo is alleged. Learned advocate for the applicants further submits that the trial Court has issued NBWs against the applicants/accused.

Without touching the merits of the case, protective bail is granted to the applicants for 03 (three) days from today subject to their furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees, Twenty five thousand only) each and P.R bonds in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court to enable them to approach the Court concerned. This order shall cease to have effect on 09.12.2020 or on the day when the applicants make their appearance before the Court concerned, whichever is earlier. The operation of NBWs issued by the trial Court against the applicants shall remain suspended for aforementioned three days It is made clear that if the applicants fail to appear before the concerned trial Court, their bail bonds furnished before this Court shall automatically stand forfeited.

Bail Application stands disposed of.
