This Court on 24.2.2014, passed following order :

“This matter was taken up in open Court for hearing and after hearing the counsel, the order was dictated in Court, whereby the applicant was granted protective bail for seven days on his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.20,000/- and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court and NBWs issued against him by the trial Court were ordered to be suspended for aforesaid period of seven days.

However, when the file was placed before me for signing the order, it was observed that earlier in time the applicant was on bail and during trial he jumped the bail and the trial Court proceeded with the case against co-accused, resulting into acquittal of the co-accused Shahnawaz while case against present applicant and co-accused Hussain Ali was ordered to be kept on dormant file vide judgment dated.14.12.2011.

In this view of the matter, it would be appropriate to issue notice to the A.P.G. Let, notice be issued to A.P.G for 03.3.2014.”

Report was called from the Court of Civil Judge/Judicial Magistrate-I, Larkana in which it is stated that accused Mushtaque has been declared proclaimed offender. Since counsel for the applicant/accused does not press instant bail application,
