Through instant petition, the petitioner has prayed for the following relief (s):-

- (a) To call upon official respondents directing them to furnish bonds that they will not take law into their hands and action if any would be in accordance with law with further directions not to conduct raids at houses of petitioner in the garb of operation in respect of dacoits;
- (b) To direct respondent No.2 to direct respondent No.4 to release the detainees, namely, Abdul Hakeem, Ghazi Jatoi and Bahadur and return looted property;
- (c) To appoint some honest and well reputed police officer to conduct fair and impartial inquiry into lodgment of false and managed case bearing F.I.R No.44, 45, 46 and 47 of 2014 registered at P.S Jaggan @ Hamayoon, District Shikarpur about their truthfulness and if it is found that F.I.Rs are false, the same be quashed;
- (d) To direct respondent No.4 to record statement of petitioner and in case a cognizable offence is made out, F.I.R of petitioner be registered;
- (e) To direct respondent No.2 to provide legal protection to petitioner and see that no harassment and humiliation is caused to petitioner and his family members.

Notices were issued to the respondents, as well as A.A.G. Comments have been filed by the respondents; in which it is stated that number of cases have been registered against the relatives of the petitioner. Petitioner says that he had appeared at Police station for lodging report but SHO refused to record his statement. Learned D.P.G and A.A.G. are present in Court and submit that petitioner had never appeared at police station; whenever he will appear before SHO P.S Jaggan @ Hamayoon, his statement shall be recorded, if cognizable offence is made out. It appears that SHO PS Jaggan @ Hamayoon is party in this case, we direct S.S.P Shikarpur, to ensure that statement of the petitioner is recorded by SHO in accordance with law. In the view of above learned advocate for petitioner does not press instant petition more and it is accordingly disposed of.
