ORDER WITH SIGNATURE OF HON'BLE JUDGE.

Through the instant Constitutional Petition, petitioners Bibi Rubina and Ashique Ali alias Ishou, have prayed for the following reliefs :-

- a) *That this Honourable Court may be pleased to direct the official respondents No.2 to 4, that provide legal protection in accordance with law and rule and further be pleased to direct them not to cause any harassment on behalf of respondents No.5 to 12 and provide legal protection to petitioner party as their lives are in danger.*
- b) *That this Honourable Court may be pleased to direct the respondents No.3 and 4 to record the statement of petitioner No.1 and direct the respondent No.3 to take legal action against private respondents No.5 to 12 is alleged is false.*
- c) *Costs of the petition may be awarded to the petitioners.*
- d) *Any other relief under the circumstances be granted to the petitioners.*

Comments have been filed by the respondent No.2. Learned advocate for the respondent No.2 placed on record statement of petitioner No.1 Bibi Rubina recorded by learned Sessions Judge, Jacobabad on 30.9.2014 in Sessions Case No.202/2014, re State vs. Khamiso Soomro, Crime No.18/2014, under Sections 365-B, 184, 149, PPC, registered at Police Station Airport, Jacobabad.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners by referring to the deposition of petitioner No.1 Bibi Rubina stated that she has clearly stated that she was not abducted at the hands of accused or absconding accused persons, but she has married with her own accord. Thereafter, Counsel for the petitioners referred to the judgment dated 30.9.2014 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Jacobabad in the aforesaid Sessions Case, which reflects that accused Khamiso was acquitted and absconding Ashique Ali, who is petitioner No.2, has also been acquitted. Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that official respondents may be directed to provide protection to the petitioners as they have married.


