
This is second bail application moved by the applicant. The earlier bail application was rejected by the trial Court as well as by this Court. The Bail Application No.1737/2016 was disposed of by this Court with directions to the trial Court to conclude the trial within two months. It is stated that the prosecution has already recorded evidence of their witnesses and it is now fixed for the evidence of defence witnesses.

At the conclusion of his arguments, though learned Counsel for the applicant has not raised any additional ground as compare to the earlier bail application referred above, he however submits that the perusal of the impugned order reveals that the trial Court has formed a view which may prejudice the case of the applicant and as such he is reluctant to proceed with the case before Court where the case is pending as far as the defence evidence is coerced.

Mr. Ali Haider Salim learned APG as well as Mr. Muhammad Arshad Tariq Counsel for complainant have opposed the bail application on merits and also reluctant to transfer the main case to another Court as it is submitted that no serious ground has been raised for its transfer.

The trial is already ordered to be concluded within two months in terms of the order passed in earlier Bail Application No.1737/2016, however the main case No.1920/2016 pending before the Court of VIth Additional District & Secessions Judge, Karachi (East) be transferred to the Court of Vth Additional District & Secessions Judge, Karachi (East) which is reluctantly conceded by Mr. Ali Haider Salim and Mr. Muhammad Arshad Tariq, with directions to conclude the trial within two months from today. No frivolous adjournment shall be granted either to the prosecution or the defence Counsel.

The bail application sands disposed of in the above terms.
