It is, *inter alia*, contended by the Counsel that the petitioners are licensee of respondents/bank and are running business of Omni shops under valid license on the basis of fixed pay-commission as per due percentage, but the respondents/bank without issuing any prior notice to the petitioners has repaid their security amount and stopped the business, hence the instant petition has been preferred by the petitioners.

It appears that the respondents/bank is a private entity and the dispute between the petitioners and the respondents/bank is in respect of contractual obligations under a license agreement, which cannot be entertained by this Court under its constitutional jurisdiction, as the resolution of such dispute requires recording of *pro* and *contra* evidence, which is domain of a civil Court. Hence this petition being not maintainable in law is dismissed in *limine*. However, the petitioners are left at liberty to approach the competent civil Court for the redressal of their grievances, if so advised.
