At the outset, learned Counsel for the Appellant submits that

charge is faulty as seemingly none of the witnesses mentioned in the

charge were examined, which destabilizes the integrity of entire process.

Learned Additional Prosecutor General submits that there appears

to be a clerical or "cut and paste" error in the charge sheet where wrong

mashirs and witnesses have been included. After carefully examining the

case record, it is evident that the procedural lapse has rendered the trial

proceedings ineffective.

In light of these circumstances, we are inclined to partly allow this

appeal. Consequently, impugned judgment is set-aside, and the matter is

remanded back to the learned Trial Court for de-novo trial with specific

instructions to reframe the charge and record the evidence of witnesses

afresh. The Trial Court is further directed to expeditiously conclude the

proceedings and decide the matter on its merits, preferably within 30 days

from the date of receipt of this order.

Let a copy of this order be promptly communicated to the learned

Trial Court for information and compliance.
