Nouman alias Nomi and others) arising out of FIR No.99 of 2019 registered at Police Station, Pano Akil under Section 395 PPC; Sessions Case No.554 of 2019 (re- State v. Nouman alias Nomi and others) arising out of FIR No.09 of 2019 registered at Police Station, Pano Akil under Section 395 PPC and Sessions Case No.431 of 2019 (re- State v. Nouman alias Nomi and others) arising out of FIR No.33 of 2019 registered at Police Station, Pano Akil under Section 395 PPC pending before the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Pano Akil to any other Court as the same is lying vacant.

While issuing notice report was called from the concerned District and Sessions Judge and it has been informed that the Additional Sessions Judge, Pano Akil has retired on 16-02-2022 and the Court is still vacant.
