Malik Naeem Iqbal advocate has argued the matter at length. While going through the comments, he read a reply to the paragraph 8 of memo of petition, which suggests that perhaps a latest summary (i) to review the need of four tiers Formula in the Province of Sindh alongwith financial implication, (ii) to review the length of service of various grades officers/teachers of Province of Sindh, (iii) to review the ratio of different grades of Lecturers, Professors, Assistant Professors and (iv) to review its implication vis-à-vis other service group in the province is under consideration. We have been informed by the learned AAG that the summary insofar as timescale upgradation and promotion is concerned has become infructuous.

The summary is available at Page 163 whereas notification of 04.8.2017 suggests that in pursuance of such summary, a committee was constituted and the job assigned to the committee was also reflected in the said notification. Thus, the outcome of the proposal of the committee is yet to be seen as to what the worthy Chief Minister has done insofar as the summary pending before him is concerned. The Petitioners claim that they would be satisfied in case an appropriate order in accordance with law in consideration of the recommendation of the committee be passed by worthy Chief Minister preferably within a period of three weeks, to which learned AAG has consented.

The petition thus in the above terms stands disposed of and a report be submitted through the MIT-II of this Court for onward transmission to this Bench.
