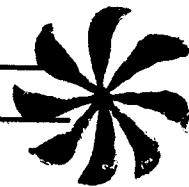

We have enquired the learned counsel as to how this Court under Article 199 of the Constitution, 1973 could invoke the jurisdiction in respect of a service contract to which he conceded that there are no statutory rules. He also conceded that the contractual terms could be enforced under plenary jurisdiction, however, such question, as we deem appropriate, cannot be probed under Article 199 of the Constitution, 1973. The jurisdiction is wrongly involved and consequently this petition is dismissed.
