2-4) For some academic exercise, in view of the frame of time for passing order-in-original, required to pass in 45 days, this petition is filed. It is claimed that despite this clear obligation, the order-inoriginal has not been passed by the authority concerned. We are unable to conceive if this proposition could be agitated under Article 199 of the Constitution of Pakistan as on account of this maladministration, this petition has been preferred. They could have approached the jurisdiction of Federal Tax Ombudsman against this maladministration, as alleged. There is nothing in this petition whereby any fundamental right of the petitioner is claimed to have been infringed or taken away. Law takes its own course if a time bound exercise is not carried out (if so required). The petition, on this preposition being misconceived is dismissed along with listed applications leaving the petitioner at liberty to exhaust the remedy available to them under the law.
