- 4. Applicant/accused Amjad Ali Laghari is present alongwith his Counsel and seeks protective bail in Crime No.GO-08 of 1998 registered at Police Station ACE Dadu for offences under Sections 409, 420, 467, 471, 477-A, 219, 34 PPC read with Section 5(2) of Act-II of 1947. Presently, the case is pending before the Court of Special Judge, Anti-Corruption Establishment (Provincial) Hyderabad. It is contended that applicant/accused is prepared to surrender before the trial Court but apprehends his arrest at the hands of the Anti-Corruption Establishment for the malafide reasons. It is further stated that N.B.Ws have been issued against the applicant/accused by the trial Court.

Without touching the merits of the case, the applicant/accused is granted protective bail for a period of 04(four) days, subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) and P.R. Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. Applicant/accused is directed to surrender himself before the trial Court within the aforesaid period. In the meanwhile, the operation of N.B.Ws issued against the applicant/accused shall remain suspended. This order shall cease to have its effect on expiry of 04(four) days from today or whenever the applicant/accused surrenders himself before the trial Court, whichever is earlier. It is made clear that in case the applicant/accused fails to surrender before the concerned Court within stipulated period, his bail bond shall stand automatically forfeited.

Bail application stands disposed of in above terms.
