4. Applicant/accused Asif Khan Agha seeks protective bail in Crime No.44 of 2017 registered at P.S Kunri for offence under Sections 353, 506(2), 147, 148, 149, 337-A(i), 337-F(i) PPC r/w 6(N) & 7 of Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997.

It is, *inter alia*, contended that name of the applicant/accused does not transpire in FIR No.44 of 2017. However, it is submitted that name of the applicant/accused has been added by the Police during investigation at latter stage. Counsel for the applicant/accused referred to Annexure "B" Page-27 and stated that name of the applicant/accused is mentioned in the remand report.

It is submitted that applicant/accused is prepared to surrender before the learned Judge, Anti-Terrorism Court, Mirpurkhas, but apprehends his arrest at the hands of the Police for the political reasons.

Without touching the merits of the case, protective bail for a period of 05(five) days is granted to the applicant/accused, subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- (Rupees One Hundred Thousand Only) and P.R. Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. Applicant/accused shall appear before the Trial Court within five days. This order shall cease to have its effect on expiry of five days from today or whenever the applicant/accused surrenders before the trial Court, whichever is earlier.

Bail application stands disposed of.
