2) This petition for Letters of Administration/succession certificate has been filed by the petitioner Aman Elahi who is one of the legal heirs of deceased Shaikh Abdul Hameed survived by the following legal heirs:-

The deceased owned two immovable properties one plot bearing No.41/1 admeasuring 592.50 sq. yards and the other one bearing No.41/2 admeasuring 592.50 sq. yards. Insofar as the second property is concerned the deceased was co-owner along with others who are his sons and daughters and hence the share of the deceased was only to the extent of 16% while in the first property the deceased was absolute owner. The deceased was also having two bank accounts both in Askari Bank Limited, DHA Branch Karachi. The bank statements in relation there to are also available on record. The Deputy Registrar has also filed a detailed report as to the assets left by the deceased and the affidavits of no objection of the legal heirs for grant of this Letters of Administration/succession certificate in favour of the petitioner. They are also present in Court and confirm the contents of their respective affidavits. Two independent witnesses are also in attendance who verify the contents of the petition.

The publication was effected in Daily Express Karachi dated 04.01.2016 but no one from any corner has appeared to raise any objection. I do not see any impediment in granting this Letters of Administration/succession certificate. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. Let Letters of Administration/Succession Certificate be issued separately in favour of the petitioner after following all codel formalities and execution of sureties as required under the lay.
