- A) That this Honourable Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No.2 to 8 not to cause harassment to the petitioner party and their family members at the instance of respondents No.9 to 18 directly or indirectly without lawful authority and also direct them not to register false cases against them without obtaining prior permission of this Honourable Court.
- To direct respondents No.2 & 3 to provide legal protection to the B) persons and properties of the petitioner party as guaranteed under the Constitution of Pakistan.
- That this Honourable Court may graciously be pleased to direct C) the respondent No.2 to call the respondent No.9 to 18 in his office where they should execute a P.R bond that they should not cause any harm to the lives and properties of the petitioner party.
- 2. Notices were issued to the respondents as well as Addl. A. G. Comments have been filed by the respondents, in which it is stated that neither the petitioner has been harassed nor the petitioner shall be harassed in future. It is further stated that the petitioner has not been forced to enter into compromise with the accused. SSP, Kashmore @ Kandhkot in the comments has categorically stated that whenever the petitioner will approach to him, he will provide protection to him according to law.

- 3. SHO PS B-Section, Kandhkot is directed to ensure that no harassment is caused to the petitioner by any body without legal justification.
- 4. In these circumstances, learned advocate for the petitioner expressed his satisfaction over the statements filed by the respondents and does not press instant petition more and it is accordingly disposed of.
