J.- Through the instant petition, the petitioners seek directions to the appointing authority in Education Department, Government of Sindh for their appointment in a lower grade post against the scheme of donation of plots to the Education Department for construction of schools as per government policy.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing the case at some length stated that they will be satisfied if the instant petitions are disposed of under the same directions already passed in CP NO.D-98 of 2011 etc.

3. Mr. Azizul Haque Solangi, Assistant A.G, at the very outset, conceded the request of the petitioners being reasonable.


4. Accordingly, the instant petitions are disposed of with directions to the concerned appointing authority of Education Department to issue appointment orders to the petitioners, after completing the codal requirements within a period of two months after furnishing the following documents by the petitioners.

- (i) Copy of Agreement Bond signed by the applicant/plot donor and EDO (E) Larkana regarding construction of School building.
- (ii) Copy of Form VII-A/ VII-B duly signed by Mukhtiarkar (Land Revenue) concerned showing the ownership of plot/land of the applicant.

- (iii) N.O.C of other shareholders of land/plot and other heirs of property.
- (iv) Qualification certificates, CNIC, Domicile and PRC of the applicant, Certificate from relevant officer that land donated for construction of school building stand transferred in the name of Education & Literacy Department, Government of Sindh.

By consent, petitions are disposed of in the above terms.
