Through the instant constitution petition filed by petitioner Muhammad Shahid on 29.09.2012, it is prayed for the following reliefs:-

- “A. To direct the respondent No.1 and other higher police authorities to take legal action against the respondents No.3 to 5 and punish them according to law in order to save the peaceful and law abiding petitioner.***
- B. To direct the respondents No.3 to 5 to return an amount of Rs.53,000/- to the petitioner.***
- C. To restrain the respondents No.3 to 5 from extending threats of dire consequences.”***

Notices were issued to the respondents as well as A.A.G. Comments have been filed by official respondents. In the comments allegation of snatching of amount from the petitioner has been denied so also the allegation of snatching of A.T.M. card. It is further stated by respondent No.5 that no harassment whatsoever has been caused to the petitioner nor the petitioner shall be harassed in future. Learned State Counsel submits that every protection as provided in law shall be provided to the petitioner and police officials shall dealt with in accordance with law. Learned advocate for petitioner is satisfied from such statements/undertakings and does not press the instant petition, it is disposed of accordingly.
