Applicant / accused (1) Syed Rafique Hussain Shah, (2) Syed Ali Hyder Shah, (3) Syed Imran Ahmed Shah, (4) Raheel Hussain Shah, (5) Arbab Ali Phulpoto and (6) Ashique Hussain Samo seek protective bail in Crime No.79/2010 registered at P.S Piryaloi, District Khairpur for offences under Sections 392, 298, 298-A, 506/2, 114, 427, 337-H(2), 147, 149, PPC and 7, ATA, 1997.

It is, inter alia, contended that co-accused Ameer Bux and 13 others have already been acquitted by learned Judge, Anti-Terrorism Court, Khairpur Mir's in Special Case No.156-A/2010. It is further stated that applicants / accused are prepared to surrender before the trial Court, but apprehend their arrest as their case is kept on dormant file and police is behind them for the mala fide reasons.

Without touching the merits of the case, protective bail for a period of **four (04) days** is granted to the applicants / accused subject to their furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Fifty thousand) each and P.R. bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Additional Registrar of this Court. Operation of NBWs is suspended for a period of four (04) days. Applicants / accused are directed to surrender before the

trial Court in the aforesaid period. This order shall cease to have effect after expiry of four (04) days or whenever the applicants / accused surrender before the trial Court, which one occurs earlier. In case, applicants / accused fail to surrender before the trial Court in the aforesaid period, their bail bonds shall stand automatically forfeited.

Criminal Bail application stands **disposed of** along with the listed applications in the above terms.
