Petitioner claims to have appeared in the recruitment process for the appointment of Excise and Taxation Inspector (BPS-14) held in year 2007 and according to him he was declared successful but was not appointed. He filed this petition in the year 2016 after 09 years of the said process challenging the said recruitment process on the ground of being tainted with malafide. We have asked the learned counsel for the petitioner to satisfy us on maintainability of this petition as no material is available on record to show that petitioner was declared successful in the said process and was not appointed to presume him being discriminated against. However, as stated above no material in this regard has been placed and therefore he has nothing to argue on besides he has not been able to satisfy us either about latches involved in this petition. This being the position, we find this petition not maintainable and dismissed it in limine.
