Learned counsel for the applicant called absent; however, the applicant, appearing in person, submits that there is a dispute between him and the proposed accused over the plots, which come within the ambit of civil dispute.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.1 to 5 submits that no plot has been occupied by the proposed accused and the applicant in order to harass the proposed accused has filed Cr. Misc. Application u/s 22-A 6(i)(iii) and 22-B Cr.P.C before the learned Additional Sessions Judge/Ex-Officio Justice of Peace, Pano Aqil. He further submits that in such type of grievance, the controversy could be resolved through the competent civil forum and not through the criminal proceedings, therefore, he prayed for dismissal of the instant application.

From perusal of record/material available before me, it appears that the learned Additional Sessions Judge/Ex-Officio Justice of Peace, Pano Aqil while dismissing Cr. Misc. Application u/s 22-A 6(i)(iii) and 22-B Cr.P.C has rightly observed that the dispute between the parties is over plots which is of civil nature and no illegality or infirmity is found in the impugned order, thus, the instant Cr. Misc. Application is **dismissed** and the impugned order of the learned Additional Sessions Judge/Ex-Officio Justice of Peace, Pano Aqil is maintained.
