Through this petition, petitioner Nadir Ali seeks following relief(s):

- a) That this Hon'abl;e Court may be pleased to direct the respondents No.6 and 10 not to cause havoc and harassment to the petitioner and his family members at the instance of private respondent.
- b) That this Hon'able Court may be pleased to direct the respondents No.2 to 5 to provide the protection to the petitioner, his family members and other villagers according to law and constitution from the hands of respondent No.6 to 10 and other their subordinate staff.
- c) That this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to call the respondents No.6 to 10 in person before this Hon'able Court and to enquire about their illegal act committed with the petitioner and further bound down them not to make any hindrance into the peaceful lives of the petitioner and his family members in future.

Official respondents No.3 & 4 have filed their comments. In the comments, the official respondents have categorically stated that there are number of cases registered against the brother, father and other family members of the petitioner. It has also been mentioned that the petitioner himself is involved in a case bearing FIR No.03/2022 under section 337-A(i), F-(i), 147, 148, PPC registered at Police Station Kamal Dero. Learned Asstt. A. G submits that the petitioner only to
