Pursuant to the advertisement published in various posts in SEPCO department, the including post of Naib Qasid and requirement thereof was "Middle Pass". It is the case of the petitioner that he being eligible and having met with the criteria for his appointment had applied for the said post. He after succeeding in the entry test was declared as successful candidate; thereafter he was called for an interview by the respondent No.6, vide letter dated 29.1.2012, but the concerned authorities issued the offer letter to their favourite persons ignoring the petitioner.

Comments were filed on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 6 wherein it was admitted that the petitioner was held successful in the written test but his educational qualification was not "Middle Pass", he was not issued appointment letter for the said post.

On 28.1.2016, this Court in order to resolve the controversy involved in this petition sent photo-state copy of Annexure-C i.e. School Leaving certificate of the petitioner to Head Master Govt. High School Badeh for verification with regard to its genuineness and in compliance thereof, on 15.9.2016, the verification report was received to this court to the effect that the said leaving certificate was genuine and the name of the petitioner was struck off during studying in class '8'. Meaning

thereby the petitioner was/is not "Middle Pass" which was the criteria/requirement for the appointment of the petitioner as Naib Qasid in SEPCO Department. S

Since, the petitioner was not holding requisite qualification, his case was not considered by the SEPCO authorities for his appointment. The petitioner failed to establish any breach of his right persuading him to maintain this petition. Accordingly, this petition being devoid of any merit stands dismissed. D
