ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J:- Despite a court order dated 28.11.2023 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II/Ex-officio Justice of Peace, Qamber, for police protection (Crl. Misc. Application No. 2435 of 2023), the petitioner continues to suffer harassment and threats to his life, liberty, and property. The petitioner's counsel reports that both police and private individuals are making unwarranted demands.

2. Official respondents 2, 3, 4, and 6 have submitted their comments, which are now on record. Respondents 7 and 8 have also appeared, providing a copy of FIR No. 89 of 2024 registered against the petitioner at Police Station Nasirabad. Following review, the petitioner's counsel now seeks disposal of the petition, requesting assurance against harassment and that all police actions adhere to legal standards. This court acknowledges that the matter falls under the jurisdiction of the competent court. This request is considered acceptable. However, no harassment is to be caused to any individual and the police shall act strictly under law. So far as the criminal cases are concerned, the same are to be dealt with by the competent Court of law and the police shall be neutral in private affairs of the parties.

3. This Court is left with no option but to direct the SSP concerned to look into the issue of harassment purportedly caused by the private respondents No.7, 8, 9, and 10 and he shall also ensure that no bodily harm shall be caused to either party.

4. In view of the above, this petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
