Mr. Ali Bux Mashori, Advocate, files power on behalf of respondent No. 5, 8 and 9.

Mr. Rizwan Ali Abro, Advocate, holds brief for Mr. Nisar Ahmed Abro, learned counsel for the petitioner. He submits that the respondents are allegedly harassing the petitioner at the behest of private respondents.

The learned counsel for the private respondents, however, states that his clients have neither harassed nor intend to harass the petitioner. He further submits that there exists a dispute between the parties, for which appropriate legal proceedings will be initiated.

Learned A.A.G. states that the official respondents have filed their statements, wherein they have categorically denied the allegations levelled by the petitioner. He further assures the Court that the official respondents shall act strictly in accordance with law and shall extend protection to the petitioner as and when required.

The petitioner's counsel expresses satisfaction with the statements made by the learned A.A.G. and counsel for the private respondents, and seeks disposal of the petition. Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to act strictly in accordance with law. No harassment shall be caused to the petitioner, and protection shall be provided to him as and when required. However, the private respondents shall remain at liberty to pursue appropriate legal remedies against the petitioner in accordance with law.
