- 1. Urgent application is granted.
- 2. Deferred.
- 3. Exemption is granted subject to all just legal exceptions.
- 4. Through this bail application, applicant/accused Akbar Ali, son of Shahzado, by caste Narejo, seeks protective bail in Crime No.251 of 2019 of Police Station ‘B’ Section, Khairpur, registered for offences under Sections 302, 324, 353, 147, 148, 149, 337-H(2), P.P.C. and Sections 6/7 of Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997.

Learned Counsel for the applicant/accused contends that the applicant is innocent, but he has been implicated by the complainant owing to tribal dispute. He further contends that the applicant/accused is ready to appear before the Court concerned along with an application under Section 498, Cr.P.C. to prove his innocence, however, he apprehends his immediate arrest as non-bailable warrants has been issued against him; hence, he seeks protective bail.

Without touching merits and de-merits of the case, protective bail for a period of **seven (07) days** w.e.f. 15.08.2023 to 21.08.2023 (*both days inclusive*) is granted to the applicant/accused subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.30,000/- (*Rupees thirty thousand*) and P.R. bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. Operation of non-bailable warrants in this case shall remain suspended during aforesaid period of seven (07) days. Applicant/accused

is directed to surrender before the Court concerned in the aforementioned period. This order shall cease to have its effect after expiry of above seven (07) days period or whenever the applicant/accused surrenders before the Court concerned, which one occurs earlier. It is made clear that in case the applicant/accused fails to surrender before the Court concerned within stipulated period, his bail bond shall stand automatically forfeited.

Criminal Bail Application stands **disposed of** in the above terms.
