Through instant petition, Mst. Shakeela Begum and Muhamad Bux Bhatti have sought legal protection against the harassment at the hands of private respondents.

Case of the petitioners is that Petitioner No.1 has contracted second marriage with petitioner No.2, such affidavit of freewill and Nikahnama are available on record as Ex-A and B, pages 19 to 21). Petitioner No.1 submits that after the death of her first husband namely Manzoor Ali, she has contracted second marriage with petitioner No.2, which annoyed her parents, who with connivance of the official respondents are causing harassment to them, therefore, protection may be provided to them.

Pursuant to notice, Mr. Ali Bux Mashori, Advocate files vakalatnama on behalf of private respondents No.6, 7 & 11, taken on record. He submits that the neither private respondents have caused harassment to the petitioners nor intend to do so. Learned Assistant Advocate General as well as Additional Prosecutor General, Sindh submit that the official respondents are ready to provide protection to the petitioners as and when required and seek disposal of the petition. When confronted, petitioners present in person, being satisfied, seek disposal of the petition in the above terms.

In view of above, instant petition is disposed of with directions to the official respondents to act strictly in accordance with law and provide protection to the Petitioners as and when required.
