ORDER

Adnan Iqbal Chaudhry J. - For reasons mentioned in the restoration application, same is allowed and the petition is restored. The question to the maintainability of the petition is taken-up. Apparently, the Respondents 5 to 49 are private persons against whom a *writ* petition is not maintainable. The primary prayer of the Petitioner is for a *writ*

to include certain other persons in an investigation ongoing in respect of an FIR. However, the Petitioner is not the complainant of said FIR and does not seem to have any nexus with the investigation. In other words, the Petitioner has no *locus standi* in the matter. Therefore, the petition is dismissed as misconceived.
