1. Urgency granted.

2-5. Learned counsel's grievance is that pursuant to the orders passed in C.P.No.D-48 of 2020, by the learned Division Bench of this Court, the Secretary Provincial Transport Authority, Sindh had made an Order dated 14.04.2021, a copy of which was also sent to the Secretary, District Regional Transport Authority, Hyderabad/Larkana as well as the S.S.Ps Hyderabad, Larkana and Qamber-Shahdadkot. Learned counsel further submits that in spite of clear cut directions by the Provincial Authority, respondent No 5 continues to defy those orders, and, that neither the SSP nor Provincial Transport Authority is paying any heed to the grievance of the petitioner. Learned counsel however submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied, if the appropriate orders are made that the instructions of the Provincial Transport Authority, Sindh dated 14.04.2021 may be complied with.

As the orders have been passed pursuant to a decision of the learned Division Bench of this Court, the Secretary, Provincial Transport Authority, Sindh should look into as to why the same are not

being complied with and in the event of non-compliance for any other reasons apart from a legal impediment, he should enforce the orders passed. In the event there is any legal impediment in complying with the orders, the same should be put into writing signed by the Secretary, Provincial Transport Authority, Sindh himself and a copy of same may be provided to the petitioner or his counsel.

Learned counsel submits that he may be granted permission that in the event he has a grievance with the Provincial Transport Authority's reasoning/final order, he may be at liberty to approach the Court for his grievance. He may do so subject to all just exceptions and in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
